OCTOBER FLASHBACK



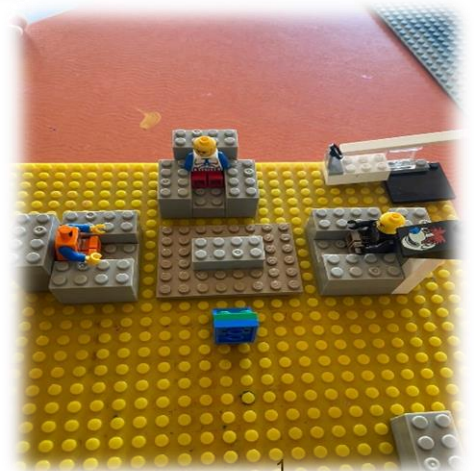
